Traditional Gascon farmhouse
in the heart of the Gers

A discreet family-owned Gascon farmhouse set amongst local vineyards, with views of the Pyrenees to the south and picturesque hilltop villages to the north.

Hidden away in south-west France, the farmhouse is situated two kms from the small village of Courrensan, and within fifteen minutes drive of the busy market towns of Condom, Eauze and Vic-Fezensac.

It is the ideal retreat for a summer holiday, situated down a short pine avenue in tranquil and unspoilt countryside, well off the tourist trail, yet buzzing with local activity. The house is an hour and thirty minutes drive from Toulouse airport and the TGV train stops at Agen, an hour north of Courrensan.



The house is well placed for a range of activities, whether you want to relax, visit historical monuments, roam the surrounding countryside, taste wine and Armagnac, cycle the rolling hills, walk sections of the Route de Saint Jacques, or paint the idyllic landscape. Tennis courts and a waterpark can be found in nearby Gondrin.

All the villages have well advertised fêtes throughout the summer and Gondrin and Vic-Fezensac have excellent Tourist Offices for any further information. A restaurant can be found in the nearby village of Lannepax and there is a charming bar in Courensan.



The house has five comfortable bedrooms including three doubles and two twins, sleeping a maximum of ten people.

All the bedrooms are large with spectacular views of the surrounding countryside and, on a clear day, the Pyrenees.



There are two sitting rooms and a large, well stocked kitchen with a gas hob, electric oven, wood burning stove and an American style fridge freezer.



Upstairs there are two bathrooms, one with a shower and one with a roll top bath. Downstairs there is a big family bathroom with shower and bath leading into a fully equipped utility room.



The large open-ended games room can house table tennis and table football tournaments for all ages and other indoor activities. The stables below provide an excellent alternative dining space.

There is a swimming pool in the old orchard, with sun loungers and pool toys all kept in the outbuildings. The pool is alarmed and the area is enclosed with gates which can be locked.

The back room is used for storing outdoor games and doubles as a larder with drinks fridge. There is an outdoor badminton court, basketball hoop and many an afternoon can be spent playing boules on the front terrace.

By air to Toulouse from Heathrow, Gatwick or Stansted. By train to Agen. By Eurotunnel. By ferry from Calais or Portsmouth.
